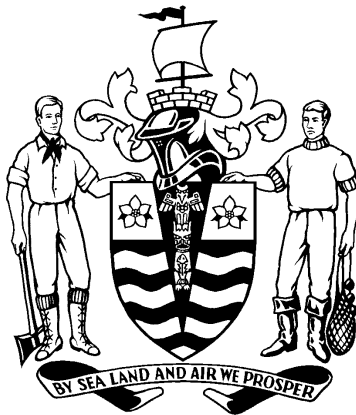

BY-LAW NO. 8022

**A By-law to designate various parts of the city
as business premises regulation of hours areas,
and to regulate closing times for certain classes
of business premises within those areas**

**[Consolidated for convenience only,
amended to include By-law No. 13703
effective April 1, 2024]**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

Name of By-law

1. The name of this By-law, for citation, is the “Business Premises Regulation of Hours By-law”.

Definitions

2. In this By-law:

“Chinatown, Gastown, Industrial, Thornton Park, and Victory Square” means those areas outlined in black on Schedule I labelled Chinatown, Gastown, Industrial, Thornton Park, and Victory Square;

“Downtown Eastside” means that area outlined in black on Schedule A;

“Downtown Eastside (DEOD)” means that area outlined in black on Schedule B;

“Downtown – Primarily Commercial” means that area outlined in black on Schedule C, and also includes the 1000-1300 blocks of Granville Street;

“Downtown – Primarily Mixed Use” means that area outlined in black on Schedule D, but does not include the 1000-1300 blocks on Granville Street;

“Downtown – Primarily Residential” means that area outlined in black on Schedule E;

“Extended Hours Liquor Establishment” has the meaning given to it in the License By-law;

“Non-Downtown – Primarily Commercial and Industrial” means that area outlined in black on Schedule F;

“Non-Downtown – Primarily Mixed Use” means that area outlined in black on Schedule G;

“Non-Downtown – Primarily Residential” means that area outlined in black on Schedule H; and

“Standard Hours Liquor Establishment” has the meaning given to it in the License By-law.

Schedules

3. The schedules attached to this By-law form part of this By-law.

Severability

4. A decision by a court that any part of this By-law is illegal, void, or unenforceable severs that part from this By-law, and is not to affect the balance of this By-law.

Designation of areas

Regulation of hours

6. The following classes of business premises in the following designated areas may remain open for business only during the following hours on the following days, and must otherwise be closed for business:

Offences under By-law

7. A person who:
- (a) violates any provision of this By-law, or does any act or thing which violates any provision of this By-law, or suffers or allows any other person to do any act or thing which violates any provision of this By-law;
 - (b) neglects to do or refrains from doing anything required to be done by any provision of this By-law; or

- (c) suffers or allows any other person to fail to comply with an order, direction, or notice given under any provision of this By-law;

is guilty of an offence against this By-law, and liable to the penalties imposed under this By-law.

Fine for offence

8. Every person who commits an offence against this By-law is punishable on conviction by a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 and not less than \$100.00 for each offence.

Fine for continuing offence

9. Every person who commits an offence of a continuing nature against this By-law is liable to a fine not less than \$250.00 and not more than \$10,000.00 for each day such offence continues.

Force and effect

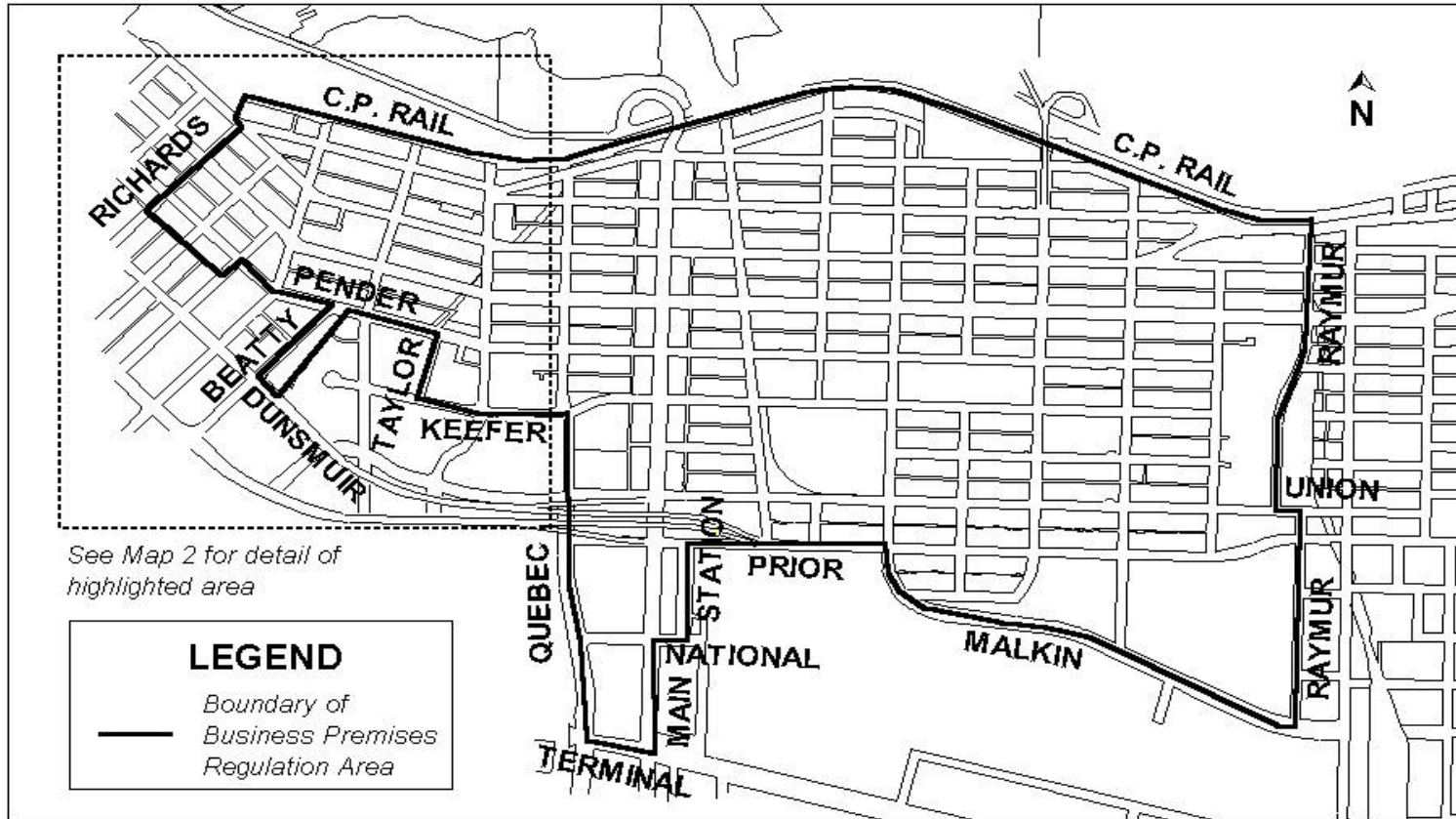
10. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on the date of its enactment.

ENACTED by Council this 27th day of April, 1999.

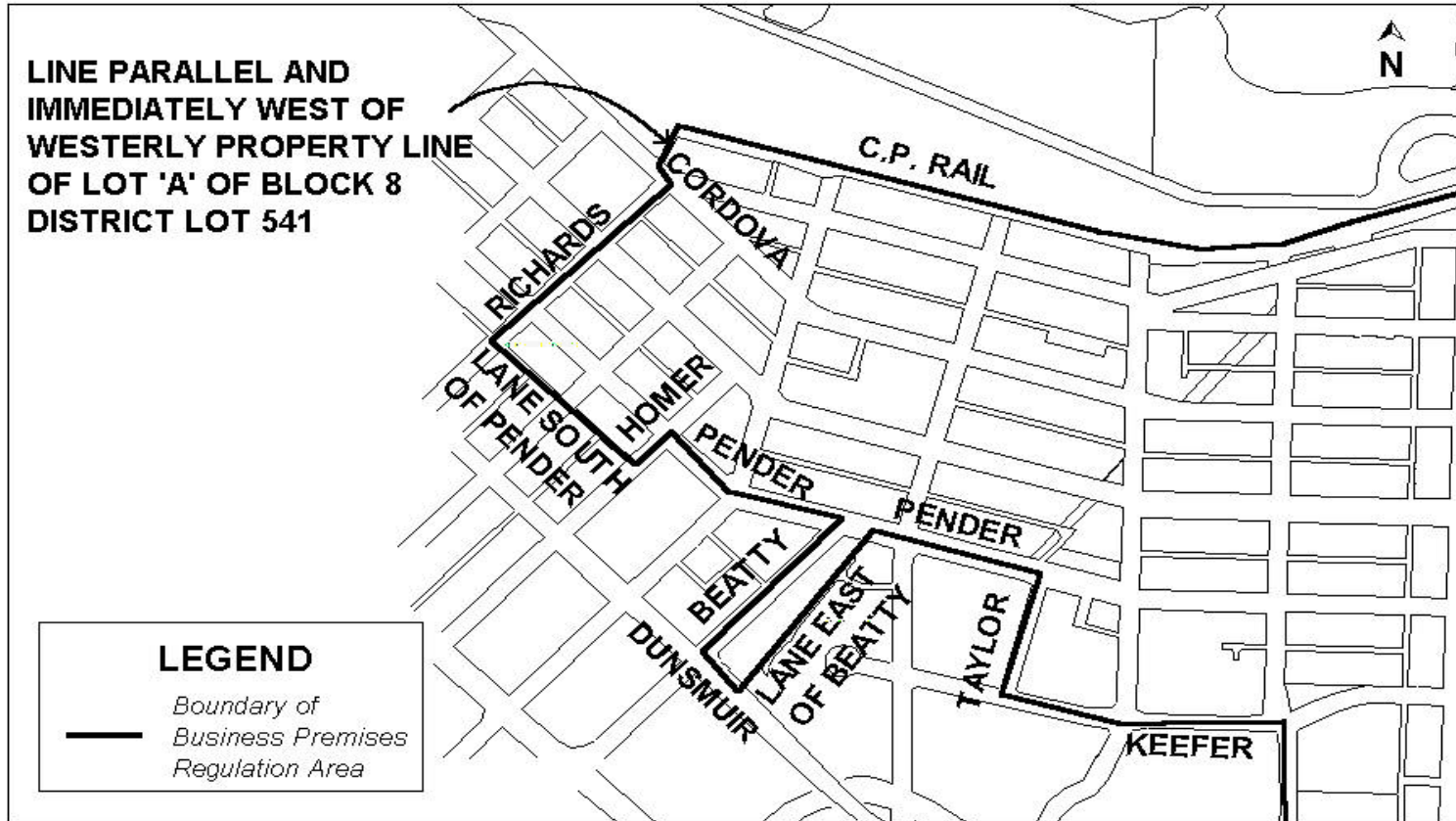

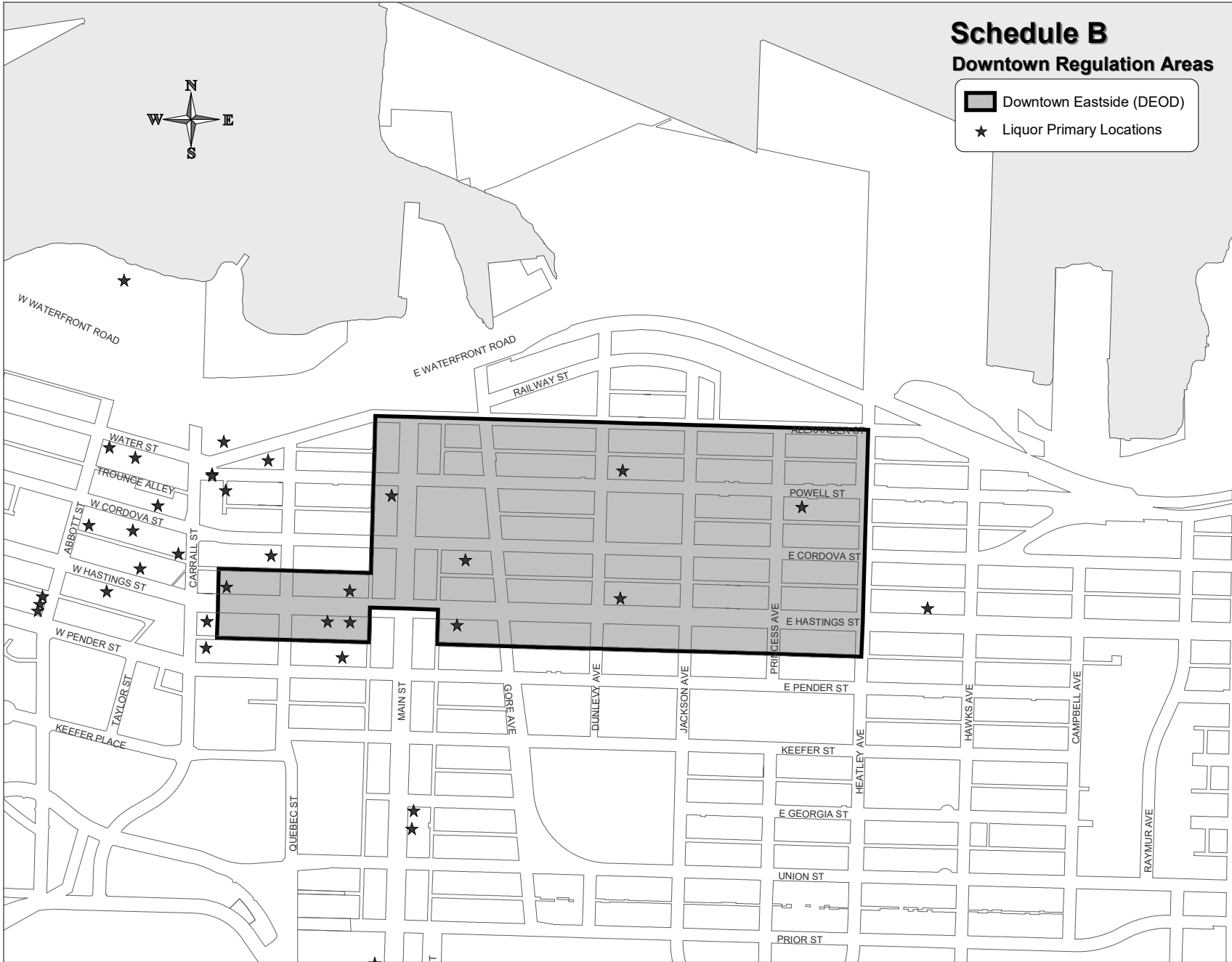

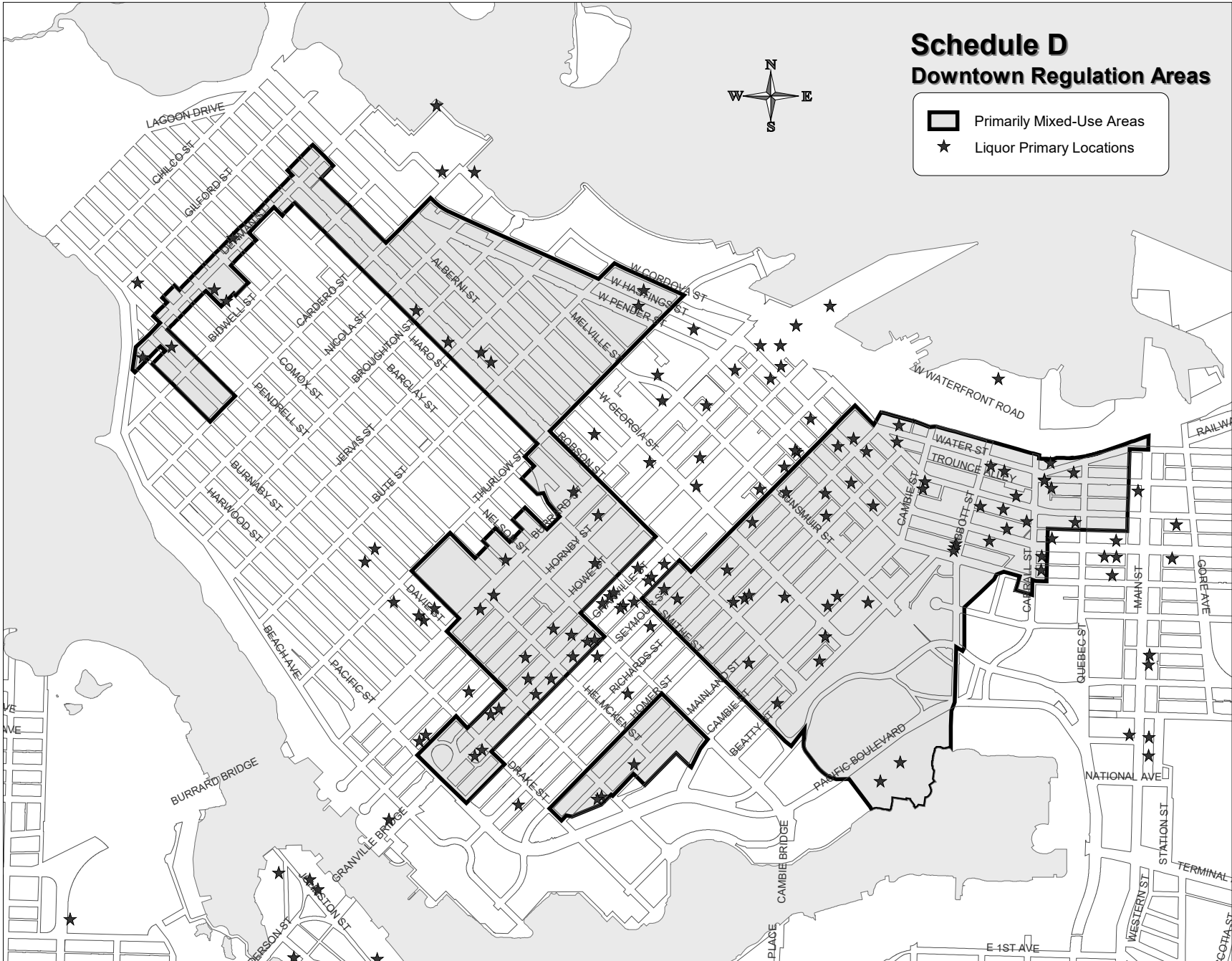
Business Premises Regulation Area



Business Premises Regulation Area



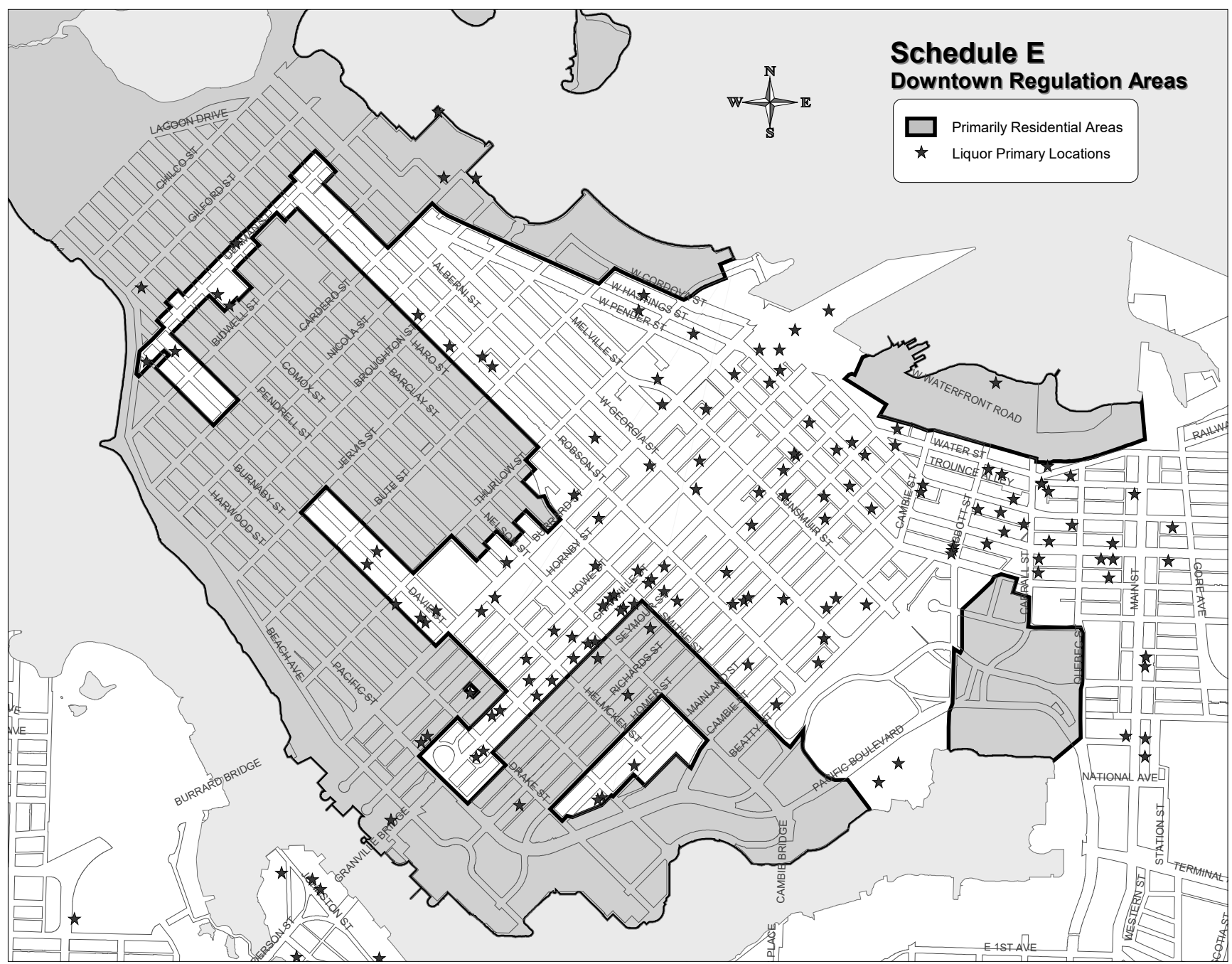


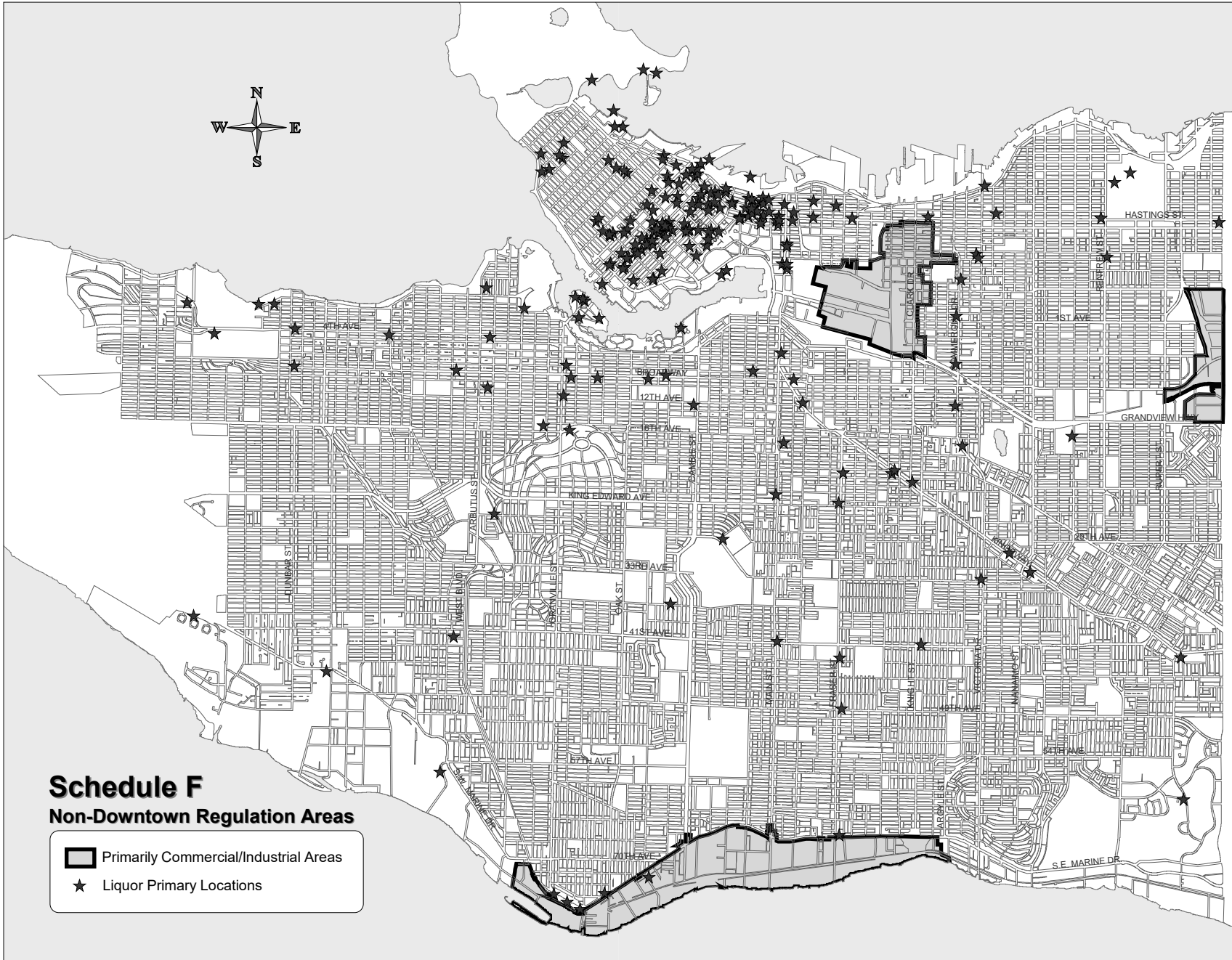


Schedule E Downtown Regulation Areas





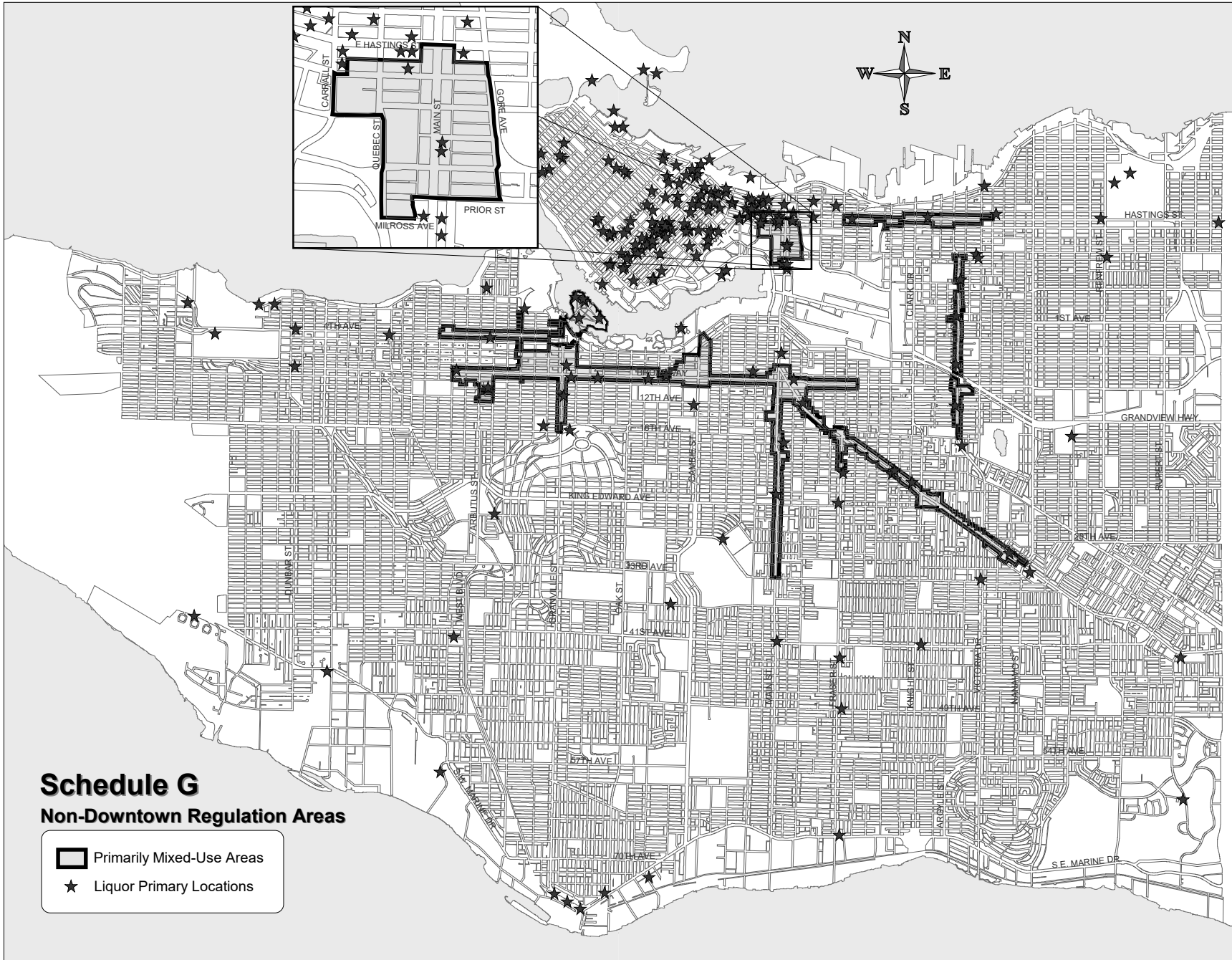
- █ Primarily Residential Areas
