Section 6

General Prohibitions

- 6.1 Despite anything to the contrary in this By-law, a person must not construct, install, place, erect, display, project, paint, alter, repair, or relocate any sign that this By-law does not expressly allow, authorize, or regulate under Section 10 or 11 or Schedules A to I inclusive.
- No person shall construct, place, erect, display, paint, alter, repair, or relocate any sign in contravention of a provision of this By-law, except that a person may maintain or repaint a sign which was approved pursuant to any other by-law of the City of Vancouver regulating signs.
- No person shall construct, place, erect, display, paint, alter, repair, or relocate any sign in contravention of a permit or a condition thereof.
- Except as provided by Section 3.2, 5.2 and 5.3, no person shall commence to construct, place, erect, display, paint, alter, repair, or relocate any sign unless a valid permit has been issued therefor and has not expired.
- No person shall continue to display a sign unless a valid permit has been issued therefor and has not expired.
- Any person who does any thing which, by this By-law, is prohibited or who fails to do any thing required of him by this By-law, commits an offence against this By-law.
