Application of By-law and Exemptions

2.1 Application of By-law to hedges

All provisions of this By-law apply to individual trees in a hedge, except only to the extent that any such provision specifically excepts, excludes, or exempts a hedge.

2.2 Exemption for small trees

This By-law does not apply to a tree that has a trunk or stem the diameter of which, or two or more trunks or stems the combined diameter of the two or three largest trunks or stems of which, measured 1.4 m above the existing grade of the ground adjoining its base, is less than 20 cm, except for a replacement tree or a tree that is part of a hedge.

2.3 Exemption for public utility

This By-law does not apply to the removal, relocation, or replacement of a tree in connection with the construction or maintenance of a public utility in a public utility easement or statutory right of way.

2.4 Exemption for Park Board

This By-law does not apply to the removal, relocation, or replacement of a tree in connection with any site or development under the jurisdiction of the Park Board.
